
# LET'S GO TO HAJJ

#### WHY IS HAJJ SO IMPORTANT?

Islam has five pillars and Hajj is the last one. Hajj is a call from Allah المنطقة that we must do if we can at least once in our life time. Hajj is held once a year during the month of Dhul-Hijja بُو الْحِجَّة which is the last month of the Islamic calendar. Muslims from all over the world go to Makkah مكتة Saudi Arabia by airplanes, ships, busses, and cars.

Hajj means Pilgrimage which is like a trip, especially a long one, made to a special place. This special place is the Ka'abah الكفيّا. Men and women walk around the Ka'abah, which is a brick building inside the largest mosque in Makkah. The Ka'abah is black because there is a black covering on it.




### REMEMBER!

Muslims do not worship the Ka'abah, we only go there to walk around the Ka'abah as a sign of unity. We worship Allah & alone.



During Hajj, all the men have to wear two pieces of white clothes called the Ihram فعرام. Everyone will look the same which shows that Allah does not judge us based on how we look. The only thing that matters is if we are good Muslims or not inside and if we act in the right way.




During Hajj, we remember the teachings of Prophet Ibrahim إبْراهِيم, who lived thousands of years ago. Prophet Ibrahim and his son Prophet Ismail معالم عبيل are the ones who re-built the Ka'abah after it was destroyed. It is a very simple brick house but it is one of the most special places in the world today.






## The Ka'abah
